Course Deposit

All applicants that are offered a place at East 15 are required to pay a £300 course deposit. Please ensure that you read the full terms and conditions for this payment.

Additional costs

Throughout your course you will be encouraged to purchase scripts, equipment and kit that will support your studies. Students are also encouraged to attend a number of professional performances. Details relating to these additional costs vary by year and by course.

The average additional costs for undergraduate courses is around £560, and for postgraduate courses, around £610.

There is some further variation in additional course-related costs for the following courses:-

- BA Stage Production and BA Creative Producing have average additional course costs of around £370
- The Certificate of Higher Education in Theatre Arts has an average additional course costs of around £300
- MA Acting has an average additional course costs of around £800
- MA Theatre Directing has an average additional course costs of around £230
