

EQUIPMENT LIST

The following list is intended to give you some guidance around how best to equip yourself to participate in a range of classes and activities. Costs listed below are indicative based on our research, however it is suggested that you shop around to find the most cost-effective option.

1.	Two pairs of jazz/yoga pants/leggings (black cotton/lycra mix) - these or equivalent items will be needed during week 2	£12 (per item)
2.	Two close fitting t-shirts or leotards - these or equivalent items will be needed during week 2	£6 (per item)
3.	One warm tracksuit or loose fitting warm clothes (no buttons or zips)	£12
4.	A device for sound recording that can create sound files such as MP3/MP4 or WAV and is compatible with Windows (required in your second year) *If you already own a smartphone you will have or can download an app that enables capture of sound	£35 or access to smartphone with app
