The following list is intended to give you some guidance around how best to equip yourself to participate in a range of classes and activities. Costs listed below are indicative based on our research, however it is suggested that you shop around to find the most cost-effective option.

1.	We suggest you put some funds aside each year to pay for theatre trips. We would like you to see at least one professional production each term. Where students are involved in performances (related to their course) at locations other than East 15, where possible we will provide support with transport to and from the venue. However, students may, on occasions, be required to fund their own transport.	£120
2.	In preparation for Voice work, we suggest you source a copy of <i>Voice into Acting</i> by Christina Gutekunst and John Gillett. This publication is available in the library, although copies are limited, and students find it useful to be able to annotate texts.	£22
